

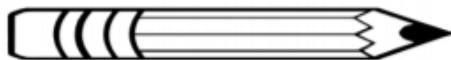
## Psalm 15:1

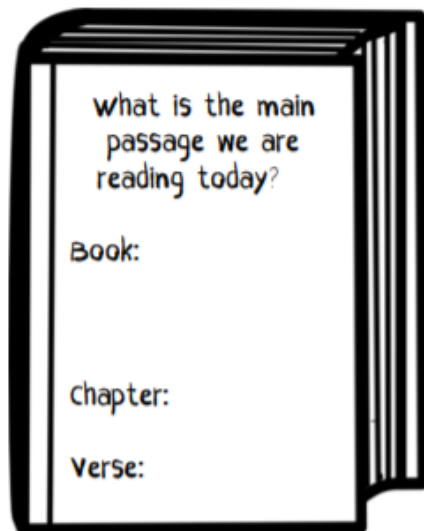
