

"Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." – Isaiah 43:19

It's a new year!! It's a fresh new calendar start on life. How will you view it this year? As a year of hope or a year of dread? As a fresh start to your life or as more-of-the-same boredom?

We love new things like new clothes, new cars (although I'm also partial to 60s muscle cars), new adventures and the like. But often we view life changes with such trepidation. We dread doctor visits and our new aches and pains in our aging bodies. We shudder at new government leaders (or cheer sometimes) and changes in the moral climate of our society. Let's not even start with having to get new insurance coverage. Often, this creates a real sense of impending doom and causes us to fear and be bitter. Rather than celebrate these changes like we would a new car, we see these as negatives. It can even cause us to become hopeless. But, this is not where our hope lies!

In the middle of being in serious oppression by Assyria, Isaiah spoke to Israel about God's promises and the hope that was coming to them. Never mind that we know the hope coming was Jesus – they didn't! All most of these Israelites had seen was slavery and disaster and it had been a long time since they had seen any hope in a physical sense. Yet here we have Isaiah telling them God hadn't forgotten them, was calling them to return to Him, and was giving them a hope in the form of a "man of sorrows" that would lead them to something entirely new... and this would be new in the best of ways. I can understand why it was hard to buy into even though we see now why they 100% should have!

God is wanting to do something new in each of us. If it weren't so, He wouldn't have said "the old has gone, the NEW has come" in 2 Corinthians 5:17. We aren't here to just get comfortable and do it the same old way every day for the rest of our lives. God will constantly push us into His likeness and into His plans. This may mean the old way that we hold dearly might just get changed into something new and uncomfortable. As hard as it seems, we will be okay if it is God's hand that is guiding us. So today, let's pray about the new work that God is doing in each of us and not push it away, but embrace it in all its uncomfortable glory. It might just be the breakthrough that causes you to grow deeper in relationship to Christ.
